

Reading Strategies

1. *Making Connections*

Share anything you think the story might be about. Tell about experiences the book reminds you of.

2. *Asking Questions*

Ask a “who, what, where, when, why or how” question.

3. *Making Predictions*

Tell what you think will happen next.

4. *Visualizing*

Place a picture in your mind about what is happening in the story.

5. *Re-Reading*

Read the sentence or paragraph again to find details or to understand better.

6. *Finding the Main Idea*

What is the paragraph, chapter, or story mostly about?

7. *Making Inferences*

“Read between the lines” or make a guess based on what is already known.
